



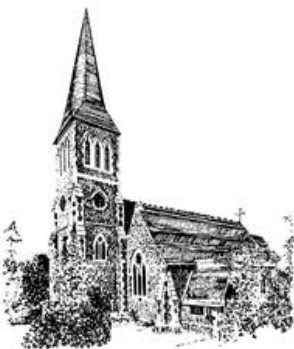

It is a unique establishment for riding for the disabled and is known and respected world-wide. It is the only Centre of its kind in the London area specialising in all fields of riding for the disabled including; dressage, carriage driving, vaulting and hippotherapy. It receives no financial support from the government or the local authority and relies solely on fees, donations, bequests and fundraising events in order to survive.
